By increasing access to healthy foods for our most vulnerable neighbors, we can positively impact long-term health and well-being of thousands.

COMING SOON

TEAM's Volunteer Income Tax Assistance (VITA) program kicks off in early February.

Households who earn under \$68,000 annually can have their taxes filed for free by TEAM's IRS-certified and trained volunteers. Residents of our region can simply call 211 or visit 211ct.org to schedule an appointment at one of TEAM's three tax prep sites in Derby, Beacon Falls, or Milford.



The VITA program not only saves families hundreds of dollars in tax prep fees, but also guarantees the maximum refund by thoroughly examining all potential tax credits for which one might qualify. Last year, TEAM filed 970 tax returns, returning \$1.8 million to families in our community.

NOW PLAYING

TEAM's Home Heating Assistance (Energy) program is in full swing.

Each winter, TEAM's Home Heating Assistance program helps keep households in our region safe and warm. Funded by the Connecticut Energy Assistance Program (CEAP), residents of our region can apply to TEAM for a set dollar amount of support to help heat their homes. TEAM will pay approved households' heating vendors directly to ensure the heat stays on and families stay safe during the cold winter months.

TEAM can also conduct full cleaning, testing and tuning of home heating systems to ensure maximum efficiency. Last winter, TEAM supported 5,638 homes.
