STAFF DEVELOPMENT DAY

TEAM employs over 200 exceptional staff who pour their hearts into the work of TEAM each day. From childcare teachers & assistant teachers, health & nutrition coordinators, & behavioral health specialists who work in our childcare centers, to Meals on Wheels drivers, Family Support Specialists, Financial Specialists, and many more, each staff member is an essential piece to TEAM's success.

VOLUNTEER INCOME TAX ASSISTANCE (VITA) PROGRAM

TEAM's Volunteer Income Tax Assistance (VITA) program ran from February through April.

Households who earn under \$68,000 annually were eligible to have their 2024 taxes filed for free by TEAM's IRS-certified and trained volunteers. TEAM operated three tax prep sites in Derby, Milford and Beacon Falls, and helped 1,090 households across our region not only gain the maximum refund for which they were eligible, but also save money on a traditional tax preparation service.

TEAM would like to thank our **31 volunteers** who gave **1,489 hours** of their time and expertise to benefit residents from across our region through the tax-filing process!



TEAM's Project MANNA provides significant shipments of fresh, healthy foods to our local partner food pantries each month. TEAM orders nutritious food items from wholesale distributor, Bozzuto's Inc., including fresh produce, dairy, proteins, etc. that are sorted and delivered to our partner pantries' shelves the same day for residents to take home to feed themselves and their loved ones. By increasing access to healthy foods for our most vulnerable neighbors, we can positively impact the long-term health and well-being of thousands.

DID YOU KNOW? Our local partner pantries serve a collective average of 2,355 residents each month!

Head Start began in 1965 under President Lyndon B. Johnson

This year marks 60 years of Head Start - the early childhood programming which provides affordable, accessible childcare for families with young children, and support services to ensure the entire family is thriving. Head Start has served nearly 40 million children nationwide since its inception, including over 500 children a year under TEAM.
